<p>Will the bidders be provided with the high-resolution file of the logo and tagline?</p>	<p>Soft copy of the high-resolution file shall be provided to bidders upon request.</p>
<p>May I humbly request for the Committee for a threshold of +/-5%. Since we cannot exactly get 60/40 fabric component. +/-5% is almost the same as the required material fabric composition specifications.</p>	<p>Request considered. The requirement for the fabric component is amended with allowable deviation of up to +/-5%.</p> <p>Please see REVISED FORM 8 for the Revised Technical Specifications attached in this Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated 12 January 2022.</p>
<p>May I humbly request that the 4 tranches be delivered within 60 days from the issuance of your Notice to Proceed. Since production and dyeing of fabrics during these challenging times usually takes 20-45 days. Additional production time will also be needed for the embroidery and the production of the shirt.</p>	<p>Request considered. The delivery period is adjusted to "within 60 calendar days from the receipt of Notice to Proceed" but we will retain the delivery in four (4) tranches to coincide with the required PTRI testing after the delivery of the first tranche.</p> <p>Please see REVISED FORM 8 for the Revised Technical Specifications attached in this Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated 12 January 2022.</p>
<p>Your fabric requirement is 60% cotton and 40% polyester. Thus, there is a tendency for the fabric to stretch during the embroidery process. Also, even if we use the same pattern with the correct measurements, still there will be some difference on the embroidery output. We will not be able to attain the exact measurements due to fabric stretchability. Industry practice provides some allowances on the embroidery output.</p>	<p>Request considered. Sizes of the DBP corporate logo and DBP Tagline are allowed with deviation of up to +/-5%.</p> <p>Please see REVISED FORM 8 for the Revised Technical Specifications attached in this Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated 12 January 2022.</p>
<p>Your fabric requirement is 60% cotton and 40% polyester. During the printing process, we subject the fabrics with prints to heating process to ensure that the prints will not fade easily. Thus, there is a tendency for the prints to shrink during the heating process. Again, even if we use the a single screen with the correct measurements, still there will be some difference on the print output. May we request for the TWG's/BAC's consideration to provide an allowance on the print outputs.</p>	<p>Request considered.
