Please advise.</p> <p>Reminder:</p> <p>1) <u>Each</u> of the above completed contract in the statement shall be supported a Copy of Certificate of Satisfactory Completion issued by bidder's client OR other analogous documents (i.e. official receipt of the full and final payment signifying completion of red teaming exercise/pen test). Bidders may use <u>Sample Template per FORM 5</u> for the Certificate of Satisfactory Completion which must be issued/signed by the bidder's client, if in case they do not have certificates of completion on file or at hand;</p> <p>2) <u>For the Oldest Contract/Project</u>, bidders must attach the copy of their oldest completed contract relative to red teaming/ pen test (confidential data maybe redacted but should still indicate client's nature of business); and</p> <p>3) <u>All completed government and private contracts within the last five (5) years shall be included in the list.</u></p>	<p>Confidential data in supporting documents (e.g., Certificate of Satisfactory Completion and official receipts of final payment) may likewise be redacted to prevent breach of bidders' confidentiality covenants with previous clients. Bidders are however reminded that said supporting documents, as the term connotes, must substantially demonstrate or provide proof of completion and traceability to the contract that it is tied to, for it to be admissible in the evaluation and be included in the scoring.</p> <p>Bidders are, nonetheless, encouraged to provide unredacted documents (as much as legally possible) to enable swift evaluation of the technical working group on the submitted bids.</p>
