II. Scope of Works/Technical Specifications:

The Contractor shall hold all obligations, duties and responsibilities necessary to the successful completion of the contract assigned to or be undertaken, including all labor, materials, equipment and services, other incidentals which are included in the overhead costs, contingencies and miscellaneous (OCM), i.e., bonds and insurance, Contractor's All Risk Insurance (CARI); and furnishings thereof in accordance with the drawings, specifications and all addenda prepared by DBP.

- 1.2 Clearances and permit requirements
- 1.3 Temporary facilities and utilities

2. SITE WORKS

- 2.1 Chipping, dismantling and demolition works (chipping of the existing concrete pavement for the anchoring of BI pipe)
- 2.2 General cleaning and hauling of debris

3. METAL WORKS

- 3.1 Metal Fabrication
 - 3.1.1 Hazardous waste storage
 50mm diameter BI pipe (schedule 40) with 25mm x 25mm x 6mm angle
 bar and 50mm x 50mm x 6mm welded wire complete with barrel bolt and
 foot bolt including the concrete filler for the anchoring to the concrete
 pavement
- 3.2 Roofing and Louvers Light Gauge Materials
 - 3.2.1 Roofing Ga. 22 pre-painted rib type GI with double faced insulation
 - 3.2.2 Flooring Ga. 22 pre-painted GI sheet

4. FINISHES

- 4.1 Quick dry enamel paint finish
 - 4.1.1 For all metal framing

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III. CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT:

- 1. The Contractor shall ensure that the items delivered are in accordance with the specifications required by DBP. DBP has the right to reject delivery if item/s delivered were found to be defective and not according to the required specifications / model.
- 2. The Contractor shall submit GANTT Chart; Construction Schedule reflecting all activities needed to complete the project, their sequence and duration.
- 3. The Contractor shall submit sample/s of materials/fixtures for approval by DBP before fabrication/installation.
- 4. The Contractor shall submit 2024 Mayor's Permit, PhilGEPS Registration No., PCAB License minimum License Category **D**, under **Classification B. General Building**, and Omnibus Sworn Statement in compliance with RA 9184.
- 5. DBP may terminate/cancel the Contract when the Contractor fails to deliver, perform and comply with its obligation.
- 6. Construction Period: The Contractor shall complete the delivery and construction within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP).
- 7. Construction Site: DBP Sta. Cruz Davao Branch, Stall No. 1, Sta. Cruz Public Market, Poblacion, Brgy., Zone III, Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur
- 8. Warranty: One (1) year warranty upon completion of all works.
- 9. Retention: The obligation for the one (1) year warranty (reckoned from the date of completion) shall be covered by either retention money or a special bank-guarantee equivalent to ten percent (10%) of the total contract amount.
- 10. Performance Security: To guarantee the faithful performance of obligations, the winning bidder is required to post within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of Notice of Award, a performance security in any of the following forms and percentages:

Cash, cashier's/manager's check issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank.	
Bank draft/guarantee or Irrevocable letter of credit issued by a Universal of Commercial Bank; provided, however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal of Commercial Bank, if issued by a foreign bank.	Ten Percent (10%)
Surety Bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security.	Thirty Percent (30%)

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- 11. The performance security shall be denominated in Philippine Pesos and posted in favor of the Procuring Entity, which shall be forfeited in the event it is established that the winning bidder is in default in any of its obligations under the contract.
- 12. The performance security shall remain valid until issuance by the Procuring Entity of the Certificate of Final Acceptance.
- 13. The performance security may be released by the Procuring Entity after the issuance of the Certificate of Final Acceptance, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Procuring Entity has no claims field against the contract awardee or the surety company;
 - b. It has no claims for labor and materials filed against the contractor; and
 - c. Other terms of the contract.

14. PAYMENT:

- 1. One-time, full payment shall be issued upon completion of all works.
- 2. Once the contract duration expires, including any time extension duly granted, and the Contractor refuses or fails to satisfactorily complete the work, DBP shall impose upon the Contractor in default liquidated damages. Liquidated damage is an amount equal to at least one tenth (1/10) of one (1) percent of the cost of the unperformed portion of the works for every day of delay. In case the total sum of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the total contract price, DBP may terminate the contract or allow the contractor to continue the works without prejudice to the continued imposition of liquidated damages until the works have been completed. This does not, however, preclude DBP in resorting to Termination of Contract under Annex I of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184
