## SUPPLY, DELIVERY, AND INSTALLATION OF FIVE (5) CCTV CAMERAS FOR KIDAPAWAN BRANCH

#### I. APPROVED BUDGET OF THE CONTRACT:

SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS - P 75,000.00 at P 15,000.00 per unit (inclusive of VAT/applicable taxes)

#### II. CAMERA SPECIFICATIONS:

- 5MP Fix IP Dome Camera real time video recording
- Lens: IRI Series 3.6mm
- Angle View: 76' (3.6mm)
- · Housing: Weather Proof IP66 rated
- Indoor/outdoor
- IR Distance 20m-25m

#### III. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The winning bidder shall supply, deliver, and install the five (5) cctv cameras within DBP Kidapawan Branch perimeter: backdoor, garage, guardhouse, rear side (gate), and front of the building.

#### IV. CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT:

- The winning bidder shall ensure that the items delivered are in accordance with the specifications required by DBP. DBP has the right to reject delivery if item/s delivered were found to be defective and not according to the required specifications/model. All damaged units, if any, shall be replaced within five (5) calendar days.
- The winning bidder, in consideration of the payment to be made by DBP, binds itself to pay, furnish and complete any and all necessary permits, materials, labor, tools, equipment, supplies, utilities, transportation, superintendence, supervision and other facilities to ensure performance on the supply, delivery, installation and testing of the units in the procuring entity.

- 3. DBP shall be free from any kind of claims, damages, liabilities or course of action in the event the winning bidder violates any terms and conditions hereof, including nay and all liabilities arising from the winning bidder's non-compliance with the requirements of the workmen's compensation, social security and other labor laws.
- 4. The winning bidder shall hold all obligations, duties and responsibilities necessary to the successful completion of the contract assigned to be undertaken by the winning bidder, including labor, materials equipment and services, other incidentals and furnishings thereof in accordance with the specifications and the addenda prepared by DBP.
- 5. The winning bidder shall be responsible for the restoration of existing structures damaged during the installation works and ensure that the cleanliness in the working area is being maintained.
- 6. DBP may terminate/cancel the Purchase Order (PO) when the Supplier fails to deliver, perform, and comply with its obligation.
- 7. Delivery Period: The winning bidder shall complete the supply, delivery, and installation of the CCTV cameras within 10 calendar days upon receipt of Purchase Order.
- 8. Point of Delivery: DBP Kidapawan Branch Building, Quezon Blvd. corner J.P. Laurel St., Kidapawan City.
- 9. Warranty: The warranty period for the fire extinguishers is one (1) year from the date of Certificate of Inspection and Acceptance.

#### VII. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

When the winning bidder fails to satisfactorily deliver goods under the contract within the specified delivery schedule, inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, the winning bidder shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall pay the procuring entity liquidated damages, not by way of penalty, an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the delayed goods scheduled for delivery for every day of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by DBP. DBP need not prove that it has incurred actual damages to be entitled to liquidated damages. Such amount shall be deducted from any money due or which may become due to the supplier, or collected from any securities or warranties posted by the winning bidder, whichever is convenient to the procuring entity concerned. In case the total sum of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%)of the total contract price, the procuring entity concerned may rescind the contract and impose appropriate sanctions over and above the liquidated damages to be paid, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
