INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Fund is a money market fund that will cater to the needs of individuals with conservative risk appetite and short-term investment horizon. It aims to generate a steady flow of income with emphasis on capital preservation through investments in the deposit products of DBP and the accredited banks of the Trustee, with remaining term to maturity of not more than three (3) years, provided the weighted average portfolio life will not exceed one (1) year). The weighted average portfolio life shall be computed by weighing the remaining term to maturity of each underlying asset by the market value. It also aims to achieve returns higher than regular savings deposit and outperform its benchmark.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process should be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the complete details of the fund in the UITF's Plan, make his/her own risk assessment, and when necessary, seek an independent/professional opinion before making an investment.

Unlad Panimula Class II Money Market Fund is suitable only for investors who:

- Are Individuals

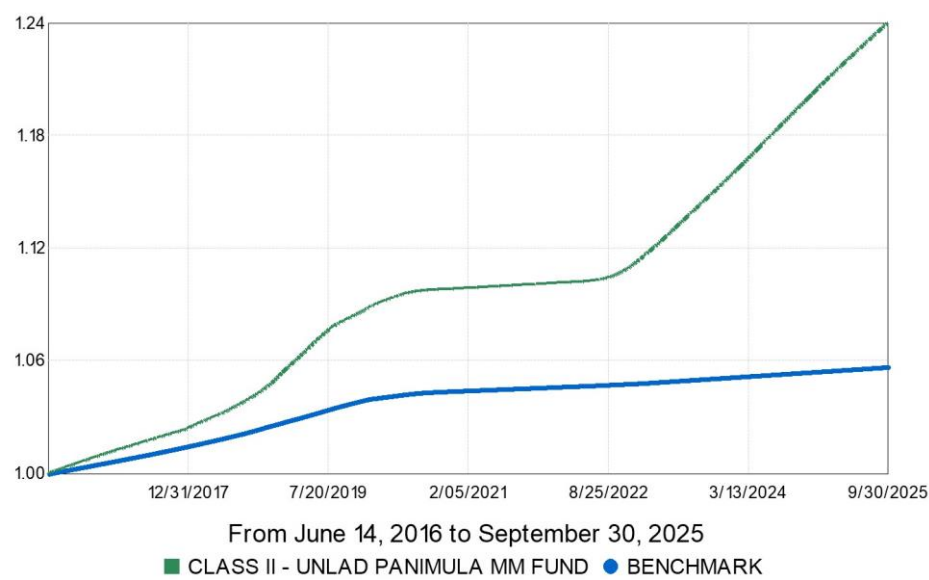

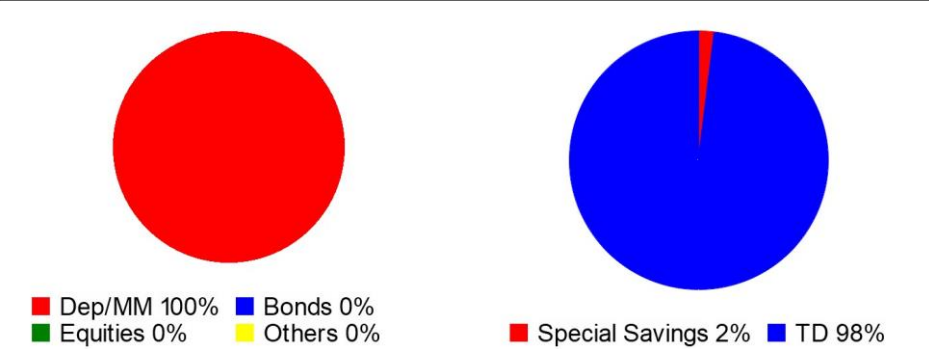

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

As of September 30, 2025, the Fund has deposits with Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) amounting to P209,883.16. Deposits with DBP, if any, shall be in accordance with the accreditation process approved by the Trust Committee. Likewise, all related party transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

September 2025 inflation increased to 1.7% versus 1.5% recorded in August 2025. The uptrend was primarily brought about by the annual increase of transport index at 1.0% from an annual decline of 0.3% in August 2025. Also contributing to the uptrend was the higher annual increment in food and non-alcoholic beverages index at 1.0% from 0.9%. This brings the average inflation rate from January to September 2025 to 1.7%. In September 2024, the inflation rate was higher at 1.9%.

As of end of September 2025, the yields for the 3-month, 6-month and one-year T-bills averaged at 4.9354%, 5.1635%, and 5.2607%, respectively, which are lower compared to the previous quarter. Meanwhile, private bank 30-day regular deposit rates averaged at 0.365%. Returns on time deposits and special savings deposits remain higher than regular savings deposit, which is beneficial to the investment strategy of the fund. The fund will continue to invest primarily in short-term placements within a 30 to 90-day range.
